Question #1	There's no page 40 in the plan set?
Answer	Corridor 40 was italicized on the quantity sheet to signify that the plan view is reflected on another page (39-54).
Question #2	Follow up action from pre-bid meeting: We will issue an addendum removing the phrase here: 7) Steel submittals (detectable warning plates, inlet grates, etc) with complete Buy America chain of custody packets
Answer	No Buy America requirements apply to the 2025 KGM Sidewalks and Concrete contract.
Question #3	How will it be possible to do compaction testing for this type of project on the sub grade, as there will not be a way to get a proctor for each location prior to the concrete being removed. Are we only getting sub grade tests on areas where over excavation is needed? Also is the road base material required to be tested. What is the frequency of testing that is required, one per day, one per location, one per street??? If the answer is follow CDOT spec, that is not clear enough for pricing on this large of a project
Answer	Sub grade conditions will be inspected by designated personnel representing the City of Greeley before Class 6 Base Course can be placed. Class 6 Base Course shall be placed at a minimum of 4" thick below all concrete and 6" below all 8" thick concrete. Class 6 Base Course will be tested for density matching the minimum testing requirements in accordance with the CDOT Field Materials Manual OA quantities with each cross pan being tested being the only exception.
Question #4	The plans call out non City spec / typical concrete thickness in multiple areas, for instance, 4" thick on ramps and sidewalks, I believe this should be 6" thick. For bidding purposes that may not be of concern. Please advise.

Answer	All ADA ramps and concrete with a propensity to experience non-commercial vehicle loads shall be 6 inches thick. Concrete experiencing commercial vehicle loads shall be 8 inches thick including residential neighborhood trash trucks. Concrete with the propensity to experience pedestrian traffic only shall be 4 inches thick.
Question #5	Is the Debarment / Suspension Certification Statement and the Subcontractors / Materials sheet required with the bid?
Answer	No, neither are required at the bid submission but will be required at the time of contract execution.
Question #6	
Answer	The New 8 Inch line item total quantity bolded and italicized on page C includes additional quantities not reflecting the total of all the corridors due to an over sought during the data collection process, but was later corrected within the plan sheets.
